
### **General Issues**

- ESU 6.828 students, 0.9 square km
- East Stroudsburg, population 9.913, 7.41 square km
- exchange students arrive few days earlier than American students on campus -> orientation week
- ullet exchange students are full-time students (attendance is mandatory)  $\to$  12 credit points = 4 classes
- class requirements (during semester)
- → homework after every session, e.g. reading or exercises
- → quizzes, exams, essays, oral presentations, in-class assignments, finals
