Student Accommodation

- **Private** accommodation (Uninest Student Residences) -> different locations in Dublin

My residence: Ardcairn House

- Different room and flat sizes
- Room with own bathroom and a shared kitchen
- Offer: gym, cinema room, music room, common room, study room , social events ...
- Location: - Dublin 7
 - Destination to TU-Dublin Grangegorman Campus: 5 min by foot
 - Destination to TU-Dublin Kevin/ Aungier Street: 25 min by foot
 - Next to Lidl
- Costs: 247 EUR per week (other student accommodations have a similar price)

Advantages:

- Central location
- Own room and own bathroom
- Gym included
- Safe to pay in advance
- Live together with international students

- Very expensive
- You have to pay in advance
- Additional costs: laundry
- You have to buy your own beddings, plates, pots ... (if no one left it there)

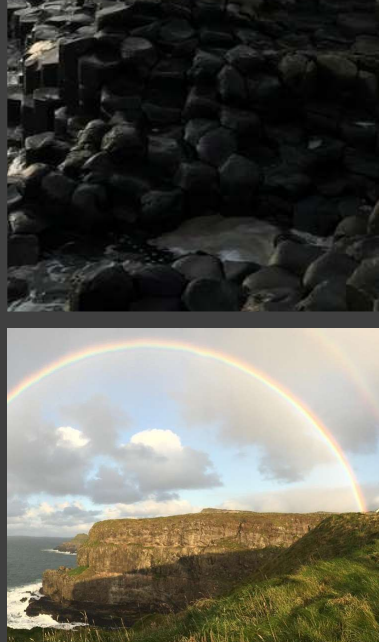
