Advantages

- Studying abroad will help you to expand your horizon and broaden your perspective;
 you will discover a new culture, enjoy student life, make new friends, and much more ...
- You will be immersed in the language and a different way of life.
- You will have the opportunity to enhance your academic skills.
- The courses you successfully complete abroad will be converted into equivalent credit points upon your return.
- You will not have to pay any tuition fees, which can otherwise cost several thousand euros. (Note: You'll have to cover an extra fee of approx. 1000\$ for East Stroudsberg.)

Duration: **10 months** (August – May) for Bethel College and Bishop's University **4 months** for East Stroudsburg

these are for **BA/BEd-students only**



Application procedure (North America)

Please include the following:

- cover page: your name, e-mail and up to three preferred destinations
- a letter in which you explain your
 motivation and attest your qualifications
 and suitability (i.e. a letter of intent)
- -your CV
- a list of all the courses you have taken
 and the grades you have received (e.g.
 your most recent transcript of records)

submit a **signed printout** of your application to Dr. Hofmann or Dr. Bauke

Deadline: December 15, 2025



Application procedure (continued)

After submitting the application:

applicants will be **interviewed** by a committee who will then nominate the chosen candidates

After having been selected:

- **enrol** at the partner university for which you have been chosen
- apply for accommodation abroad
- choose the classes/modules you wish to attend at the respective partner university
- promptly draw up a learning agreement that outlines the classes/modules you
 intend to take at the partner university
- USA/Canada: apply for a visa at the respective consulate in Frankfurt am Main



Talking money

- North America: **PROMOS** is a scholarship program that is funded by the DAAD and the BMBF to encourage and support students' mobility worldwide.

Candidates chosen for a scholarship program are awarded a small monthly grant to help them cover the cost of their trip.

Even if you are not entitled to Inlands-BAföG, you may still be entitled to **Auslands-BAföG**. This is due to the fact that in connection with studying abroad, which is always more expensive than studying at home, a higher basic allowance is taken into account when you apply for the latter. Therefore, in either case, we strongly advise you to apply for Auslands-BAföG here.
