




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# Our partner university in the UK



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## Advantages

- Studying abroad will help you to expand your horizon and broaden your perspective; you will discover a new culture, enjoy student life, make new friends, and much more ...
- You will be immersed in the language and a different way of life.
- You will have the opportunity to enhance your academic skills.
- The courses you successfully complete abroad will be converted into equivalent credit points upon your return.
- You will not have to pay any tuition fees, which can otherwise cost several thousand euros.

Duration: **10 months** (August – May) or **5 months** (August – December or January – May), depending on your personal preferences, and our agreement with the partner university

*apart from one MA/MEd-spot\* in Maynooth + Birmingham, these are for **BA/BEd-students***

\* Please note that you cannot apply for your MEd before having been abroad for 3 months. This spot can therefore not be used to fulfill the application requirements!

## Application procedure

### Please include the following:

- cover page: your name, e-mail and your preferred destination(s)
- a letter in which you explain your motivation and attest your qualifications and suitability (i.e. a letter of intent)
- your CV
- a list of all the courses you have taken and the grades you have received (e.g. your most recent transcript of records)

### ERASMUS+:

- apply for a place at one of our partner universities via the web platform *Mobility Online* (open Dec 1 - Jan 15)
- upload all the required documents (basically the ones on the left that you hand in to the Department of English and American Studies anyway, plus a *Studienbescheinigung*)

**You need to do both!!!**

**Deadline for both: January 15, 2026**

## Application procedure (continued)

After submitting the application:

Selected applicants will be **interviewed** by a committee who will then nominate the candidates.

After having been nominated:

- **enrol** at the partner university for which you have been chosen
- **apply for accommodation** abroad
- **choose the classes/modules** you wish to attend at the respective partner university
- promptly draw up a **learning agreement** that outlines the classes/modules you intend to take at the partner university

## Talking money

- **ERASMUS+** is a scholarship program that is funded by the European Union to encourage and support students' mobility within Europe.

Candidates chosen for a scholarship program are awarded a small monthly grant to help them cover the cost of their trip.


Even if you are not entitled to Inlands-BAföG, you may still be entitled to **Auslands-BAföG**. This is due to the fact that in connection with studying abroad, which is always more expensive than studying at home, a higher basic allowance is taken into account when you apply for the latter. Therefore, in either case, we strongly advise you to apply for Auslands-BAföG [here](#).
